

Major Transactions and Related-Party Transactions

Major Transactions

In 2016, Moscow Exchange did not engage in any transactions deemed to be major transactions pursuant to Federal Law No. 208-FZ On Joint-Stock Companies dated 26 December 1995.

The Moscow Exchange Charter does not define any other transactions that would be subject to the major transactions approval procedure.

Related-Party Transactions

During the reporting year 2016, Moscow Exchange entered into transactions that qualify under the Federal Law On Joint-Stock Companies as related-party transactions that required approval pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Federal Law on Joint Stock Companies.

During the year Moscow Exchange did not take part in any related-party transactions, the value of which was 2% or more of the carrying amount of the Exchange's assets.

The information on the transactions made in 2016 is contained in the Report on Moscow Exchange's Related-Party Transactions in 2016 (the "Report"), which was approved by the Exchange's Supervisory Board on 27 March 2017 (minutes No. 16).
